## National Scoring Rules 2024

## General

In the national classes, up to 2 gymnasts may start who are older or younger than the age limit of that competition class. Each gymnast may only start in one team per competition. The age requirements can be found in the invitation.

For organizational communication between athletes and coaches (e.g. order on tumbling) there is no deduction in "Nachwuchsklasse". Technical instructions are not permitted here either.

If there are more than 8 teams registered in a competition class, individual classes can be subdivided. Either in male, female, mixed, or according to age or team size.

## Floor

Different grip options/hand placements are allowed within the team without any deductions. In national classes, there is no required distribution of the elements considering the time.

## Tumbling

In national classes may always be 2 additional gymnasts who will not be judged. Always the first 4 or 6 gymnasts are the ones to be judged.

Doubles and multiple twists are not permitted in the open class ("Offene Klasse"). Therefore, the maximal difficulty score rewarded per round is 2,5 points.

1*) Elements may be repeated, but will not receive difficulty. No deduction for repetition. (e.g.: cartwheel + cartwheel and single cartwheel are two different series with the same difficulty)

2*) One round with at least a front handspring to both legs and one round with at least roundoff - back handspring. Deductions for every missing front handspring and roundoff - back handspring (E1: -0,1 points of final score)
$3^{*}$ ) One round with at least a front handspring to both legs and one round with at least roundoff - back handspring. The mandatory elements of "Schülerklasse" are rewarded by E1 with $+0,1$ points.

## Trampet

In national classes may always be 2 additional gymnasts who will not be judged. Always the first 4 or 6 gymnasts are the ones to be judged.

In "Nachwuchsklasse" a springboard is allowed in front of the trampoline.
Doubles, Tsukahara, and multiple twists are not permitted in "Offene Klasse". Therefore, each round a maximum of 2,2 points in difficulty will be rewarded.
